Learning Objectives	 At the end of this session, participants will be able to: Assess and treat common complications that cause pain and movement impairment post breast cancer treatment. Use the Arm to Ear Test and Reach-out-the-Back Test to assess shoulder movement and cording. Understand the difference between these two tests and shoulder flexion and abduction ROM test. Assess mastectomy scars using 2 techniques. Evaluate scar assessment tools mentioned in the research literature (rating scales and objective measures). Know the limitations of scar rating scales for breast cancer scars. Understand the value of Lewit Level 1 stretch or PIR for this client group. Use Lewit Barrier Release Technique for treatment of mastectomy scar adhesions and cording. Set realistic recovery goals for upper limb recovery post breast cancer, based on research on chronic shoulder dysfunction.
